Safeguarding Training for a major INGO sponsored programme in **Bangladesh.** A safe space allows a discussion about power dynamics that can lead to harm. In this programme we trained over 100 people simultaneously in 4 different countries.



A 12 month project collecting and analysing large data sets across 30 indices to be able to categorise safeguarding risks accurately in over 140 countries.

This data-driven approach allows specific country and programme level analysis of key safeguarding risks, ensuring response -including training design- is relevant to local context.

The process was peer reviewed and endorsed in 2019 by UCL and is now being used in a number of programmes.
