
Safer Edge's safeguarding services focus on by being **proactive and innovative**. All of our training, consulting and technology is designed to empower individuals to discover and prevent harm.

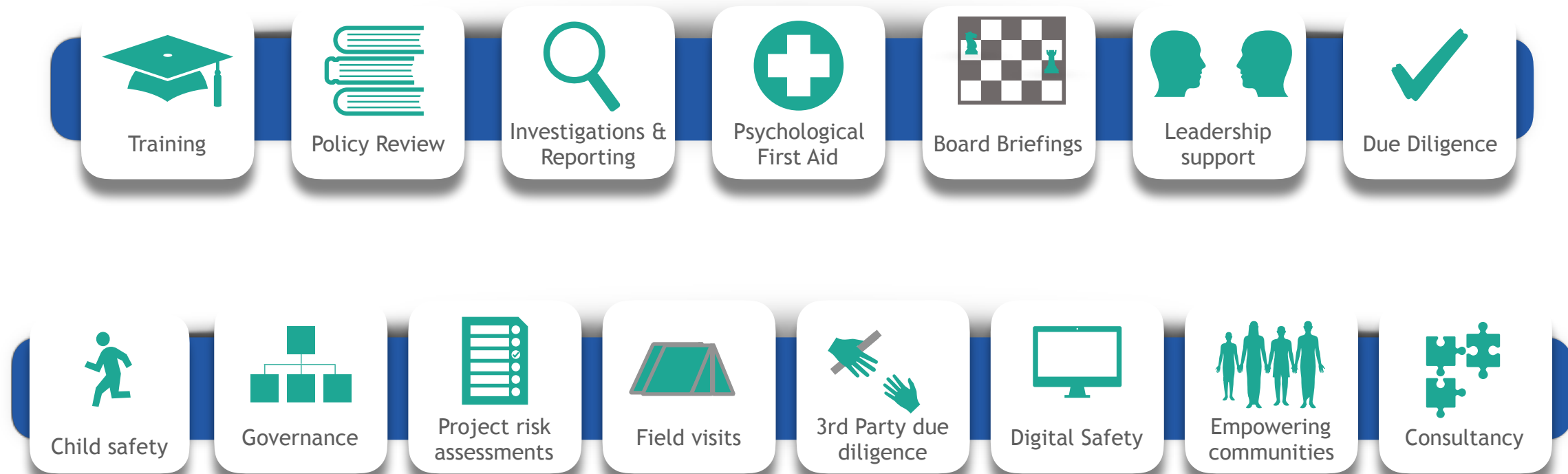

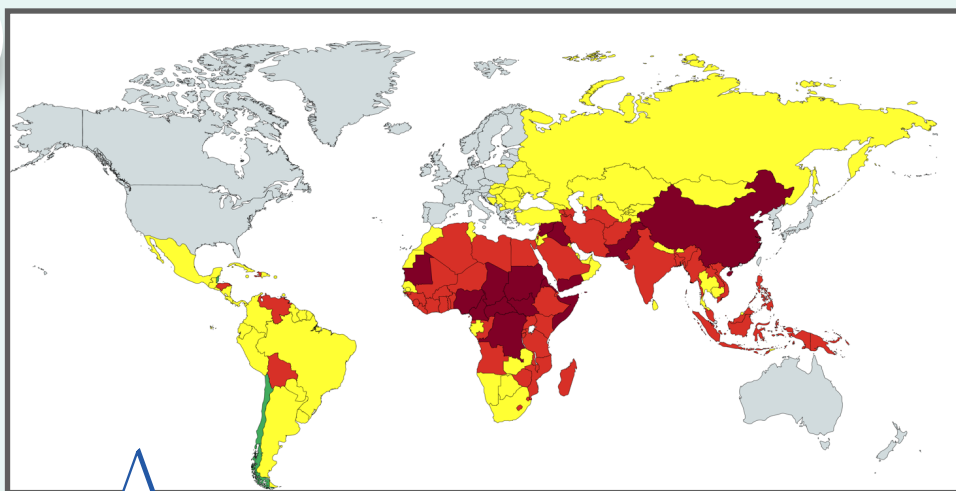
